



There are only a few reasons your landlord can evict you right now

You cannot be evicted for not paying rent for COVID-19-related reasons, under federal and state eviction orders, until December 31, 2020

You still may be evicted if you cause an immediate and substantial risk to health, safety or property*

You are still responsible to pay your rent. If you do not pay, you will owe a lot more later!

**The federal order likely prohibits a landlord evicting you so they can move in or sell.*

If you cannot pay all your rent, your landlord should offer a reasonable payment plan in writing. ***If your landlord tries to evict you, try to get legal help right away.***
